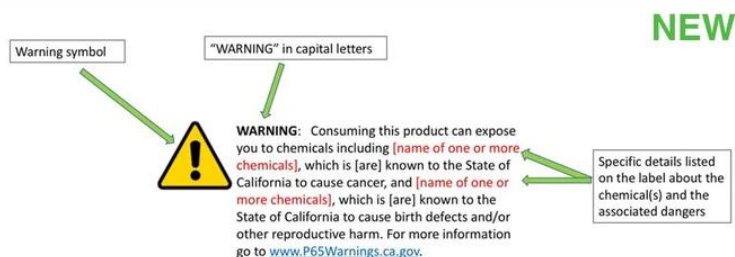
RE: California Proposition 65 Warning Language  
Parker Hannifin Corp. – Engineered Materials Group – Chomerics Division

This letter is regarding inquiries about compliance to Prop65 warning labels on Parker Hannifin, Chomerics Division products shipped to the state of California or within the United States.

Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act Enacted in 1986 in the state of California was first intended to protect drinking water from being contaminated with chemicals known to cause cancer (carcinogens), birth defects, or other reproductive harm (reproductive toxicants). Proposition 65 requires businesses operating in California, as well as businesses marketing products in California, to put warning notices on any product containing P65 listed chemicals unless the seller can show the following circumstances:

- If individuals are not exposed to Proposition 65-listed chemicals,
- If the exposures are at or below safe harbor levels, or
- If the level in the product poses no significant cancer risk or is substantially below the level observed to cause reproductive health effects.

Chomerics reviews the Prop65 list annually to provide updates to both the Prop65 Warning labels (see Figure 1) and Safety Data Sheets (SDS, Section 15) as required.
