IARC has designated titanium dioxide (TiO₂) as Group 2B – possibly

carcinogenic to humans in dust form. However, a number of long term animal studies and human epidemiology studies evaluating TiO₂ and workplace exposure show insufficient evidence for carcinogenic effects. EPA, NTP and OSHA do not designate TiO₂ as a carcinogen and ACGIH designates TiO₂ as A4 - not classifiable as a human carcinogen. Mortality from other chronic diseases, including other respiratory diseases, was not associated with exposure to TiO₂ dust. TiO₂ is not present in this product as a dust and no airborne exposure is expected during application.
